

STABLING

1. Stabling is available at Amberlea Meadows for all competitors at a rate of \$45.00 a night or \$35.00 for a day stall. Stabling fees will include one straw bale for bedding. Shavings are available for \$9.00 per bag, if shavings bedding is your preference. Tack stalls are available at \$35.00 a night.

2. Feed and bedding is available for sale from the show office.

3. No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall with-out approval from management.

HAUL-INS

The haul-in fee per horse is \$20 per day. Trailer and haul in parking are the parking lot across from the horse show office.

ENTRIES

Payment must be made in full including GST, for each horse entered. An open cheque or credit card number must accompany the completed entry form. Numbers will not be issued without a cheque or credit card number to cover the balance. Please make cheques payable to Amberlea Meadows. A fee of \$40.00 will be charged for any NSF cheques. Class Fees are \$15.00 Per Class.

REFUNDS

Exhibitors cancelling their entry before the closing date will be issued a full refund. After the closing date of entries but prior to the start of the tournament exhibitors or, competitors shall, upon presentation of a valid veterinarian certificate, forfeit their stall and office fee's, all other fees will be refunded. Non vet scratches will not be refunded after the closing date

Hunter Hack: Riders work on the flat, and over two jumps. Judged on the horse.

Hunter Over Fences: Judged on the horse's way of going around a course.

Rider's Revenge—Set of Fences at 2'0" to be jumped. Family member or friend to run a course. The pair's total time will commence when rider 1 crosses the start line and finishes when friend or family member crosses the finish line.

Steady Eddie—Riders hold cups of water throughout the class trying not to spill!!! At the end of the class rider with the fullest cup wins.
