“Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of the EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.

### **STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE**

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

- EC is committed to:
- Upholding the welfare of the horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that owners, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition;
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

Per Article A801 every entry at an EC- sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC- sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition.

Do not participate in this EC- sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.

## **GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION**

1. The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. EC rules and regulations will be followed.
2. The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class not filled to satisfaction; whereupon exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries.
3. Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees.
4. Any exhibitor using a wrong number, or having no number, may be excused or disqualified from the class, at the judge's discretion.
5. Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Management reserves the right to remove a groom, handler/ rider and/ or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.
6. No judge shall be approached with regard to any decision during the time he is judging or is about to judge. Penalty will be disqualification from the show in its entirety.
7. The medical aid fee covers the cost of the medical aid on site. The fee does not cover personal expenses incurred by the injured party in the event of an injury or transportation by ambulance.
8. No person other than officials, staff on duty, and the judges of the classes may enter the competition rings without permission of the tournament management. Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing, when the course is open for walking or during scheduled schooling rounds.
9. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. For safety and sanitary reasons, no dogs will be permitted in the schooling area, show rings or show office.
10. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location. Drug Fee \$3.50.

## **HARD HATS AND ATTIRE**

1. All competitors, including foreign competitors, must wear ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times while mounted on the competition grounds.
2. Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headwear with the attached safety harness fastened.
3. Failure to comply with points 1 and 2 above in the exercise area and/or the competition arena will result in the following penalties:
  - a) 1<sup>st</sup> violation at competition: warning
  - b) 2<sup>nd</sup> violation at same competition: disqualification from the competition and forfeiture of all fees and prize monies
4. We would appreciate a formal turnout.  
Hunter Ring- braiding and hunt jackets at all times  
Jumper Ring - (Saturday and Sunday)- Hunt jackets are required.
5. Please remember that every entry must wear the number it was issued visibly at all times in the schooling and/or exercise areas as well as in the competition ring. (A 603 and A 814) All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear properly fitted and fastened safety approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned competition at the event location.

## **ENTRIES**

---

1. Entries for the Amberlea Meadows Harvest Horse Show must use the Amberlea Meadows Harvest Horse Show entry form **(Must be received by September 5, 2017)**
2. Payment must be made in full including GST. Please make cheques payable to Amberlea Meadows. A fee of \$40.00 will be charged for any NSF cheques.
3. Entry forms must be signed. A parent/legal guardian must sign for juniors. A trainer's signature is not valid. No numbers will be released without the required signatures.
4. Late entries may be accepted up to the date of the show, subject to the approval of the show management and must be accompanied with payment of a \$50.00 late fee.
5. Substitutions and Transfer of entries.  
There will be NO office charge per add/scratch sheet if done the day before the competition starts for horses already entered prior to the closing date. **All changes must be made no later than ½ hour after the last class of the day.** Late and same day changes will be charged \$10.00 per class/division. Any Exhibitor who does not compete in a class(es) in which the exhibitor is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the scratch procedure will be billed for the class(es). You **MUST** do your paperwork in the Show Office to avoid this penalty.
6. Please list your coach's name on the entry form, if you ride with one, to facilitate the draws for class order.
7. Cancellations prior to the closing date will have all fees less the Administration Fee refunded. Cancellations after the closing date – Before the start of the horse show with a veterinary certificate or medical certificate will have stabling fees, drug fees, EC Levy and 50% of the class fees refunded. Cancellations after this date will forfeit all fees. Substitutions will be permitted, prior to the start of the show. Cancellations for any other reason are not entitled to a refund.
8. The management reserves the right to limit entries in any division and to refuse or decline any entry without being liable for compensation or damages.

## **HORS CONCOURS**

---

1. Hors Concours Pertaining to Dressage ARTICLE E 7.11.11 With permission of the competition committee, horses may be entered hors concours (non-competitive)
2. Hors Concours Pertaining to Jumpers -Article G501  
"Hors Concours" entries maybe accepted at the competition committee's discretion but are subject to the same rules as a regular entry."Hors Concours" may not participate in any jump off. A horse or pony that has competed "Hors Concours" is not allowed to compete subsequently in the same ring on the same day.
3. Pertaining to Hunter Classes - Article G302.2 and G1101 No Horse or pony will be allowed to show "Hors Concours" in hunter divisions equitation and medal classes.

## **STABLING**

---

1. Stabling at Amberlea Meadows for competitors at a rate of \$90.00 + GST for the duration of the show. Tack stalls are available for \$75.00 + GST for the duration of the show. Hauling in for the day is allowed, and a day stall may be purchased for \$45/ day. Haul-ins are also allowed for a Haul in fee of \$30/day.
2. Feed and bedding is available for sale from the show office.\* **Bedding must be ordered on your entry form\*.**
3. No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall without approval from management.
4. Stabling will be available from September 15 and be vacated at the end of the competition on Sept. 17.

## **RV PARKING**

---

Campers or motor homes are to be parked in the southwest parking lot by the arena, where plug-ins are available for \$30/ night + GST. No RV's with propane tanks will be allowed to park within 50 feet of any building to avoid potential fire risk. Showers are available for public use in the main barn area. A septic tank dumping station is also available for use.

# **TROPHIES, RIBBONS AND PRIZE MONEY**

## **DRESSAGE**

1. \$100 will be awarded for the following divisions Walk/Trot, Training Level, First Level. Payout will be divided as follows 1<sup>st</sup> 40%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20%, 4<sup>th</sup> 10%. Ribbons will be awarded for every class.
2. There will be a Junior High Score trophy donated by the Burkell Family and a Open High Score Trophy. The 2 top tests of 3 possible tests ridden will be tabulated for the Championship in each Dressage Division.
3. Championship awards will be awarded for Walk/Trot, Training, First Level (Junior & Open)
4. High Point Junior and Open Dressage/Hunter trophies. Tabulation of points will be as per Hunter Section 3 below. Classes 1,2,3,17,18,19, are not eligible for dressage/hunter high score tabulations. (EC points)
5. Open Costume Freestyle- All horses entered in the show.. Scores will be calculated 30% on Costume and 70% on the Freestyle Test.( A Costume Freestyle High Score Prize will be awarded.)

## **HUNTER and JUMPER**

1. Ribbons will be awarded for every class.
2. Prize money of \$100 will be awarded to 4<sup>th</sup> place in all Stake Classes. Payout will be divided as follows 1<sup>st</sup> 40%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20%, 4<sup>th</sup> 10%. To enter a stake class, a horse must have been shown, and judged, in at least one class over fences in the respective division.
3. Champion and Reserve Champion will be named in all divisions and awards will be made. Points will be awarded to 6th place based on the following system:

**Jumper Championship:** The Champion and Reserve Champion titles shall be awarded to the two horses that have accumulated the most points performing over fences in the division in which they are being shown. In the case of a tie for the championship there may be a jump-off after the last jumping class of the competition. Exhibitors tied for Champion or reserve may elect to jump-off or toss a coin.

**Hunter Championship:** The Champion and Reserve Champion titles shall be awarded to two of the four horses that have accumulated the most points performing over fences in the division in which they are being shown. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive points for ribbons won in the under saddle class. In the case of a tie, the Championship and/or Reserve shall be awarded to the horse that has accumulated the most points over fences. In the event there is still a tie, the tied horses shall be shown at walk, trot, and canter to determine championship and reserve. This competition shall be judged as an independent Hunter Under Saddle class with conformation, quality, substance, soundness and performance to count as prescribed throughout the appropriate division. Tossing a coin to break the tie is permissible if all participants agree.

## **SCHOOLING ROUNDS**

1. **Hunter & Jumper(sand) schooling rounds** will be available (weather permitting) from 10:00 am until 8:00 pm on Friday, September 15. (Times may change slightly, subject to demand.) Schooling round times may be booked in blocks for stables. Please call the office at 955-7608 to book a 'block time'. Individual rounds may also be booked at the in gate.
2. Purchase of a schooling round pass, will enable the horse to participate in unlimited schooling rounds in any of the rings during the schooling times. The horse must have its competitions number on. Pass price \$30.00 per horse.
3. Only horses entered into a minimum of one division in the tournament are eligible to participate in schooling rounds
4. Dressage Schooling Time - The show rings will be open for practice prior to the show. Times will be posted at the show office if entries warrant. No warm-up in the show rings is allowed from Saturday AM. till the conclusion of the show.
