GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- It is compulsory for the horse's competition number to be worn by the horse/ rider/ handler in exercise and schooling areas from the time the number is issued to the end of the competition to identify the horse. Failure to comply will result in a warning for the first offense and possible elimination for subsequent offenses.
- Any riding time changes must be approved by the show secretary prior to the competition.
- No person other than the officials, attendants, on duty and the judges of the class may enter the show ring without permission from the officials. Competitors entering the arena outside of the posted warm up times will be eliminated.
- Inhumane treatment of a horse including polling, rapping or other abuse will not be tolerated and any exhibitor will be disqualified for such an offence.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to remove any horse/ rider from the competition without being liable for compensation.
- There will be no test readers provided by the show, all riders must supply their own readers.
- Standard whip length is 120cm. (including lash) and ponies riding in ANY class can only carry a whip of 100cm. Including lash.
- Dogs are always welcome at Amberlea Meadows however for safety reasons, we ask that you please keep your dog on a leash at all times. For safety and sanitary reasons, no dogs will be permitted in the schooling area, show rings or show office.
- Riders must wear approved helmets at all times while riding on show grounds.
- SCHOOLING TIME - The show rings will be open for practice prior to the show.

CLASSES

- Each horse/ pony is limited to a maximum of 4 technical tests per day.
- Tests from Walk/Trot and Training will be ridden in a 20 x 40 ring. First Level Test 1 to FEI will be ridden in the 20 x 60 ring for the duration of the show.
- Classes may be rescheduled at any time on the day listed in this class schedule. Ride times will only be changed in the case of error, overlapping times, or to facilitate the running of the show. Riders of multiple horses should enter as early as possible to avoid schedule conflicts. Final times posted at the show. Times are only an approximation.
- Day sheets will be posted and competitors need to pay attention to the show office, announcements and class time postings.
- Class Ribbons will be given by category of rider (Junior, Amateur, Open) Placing to 6th.

STABLE RULES

- Stabling is available at Amberlea Meadows for all competitors at a rate of \$50.00 a night or \$40.00 for a day stall. Stabling fees will include (1) straw bale for bedding. Additional bales available for \$5.00 a bale. Shavings are available for \$9.00 per bag, if shavings bedding is your preference. Tack stalls are available at \$40.00 a night.
- Feed and bedding is available for sale from the show office.
- No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall without approval from management discretion of the Show Manager. Special requests should be noted on the entry form, and will be accommodated at the discretion of show management.
- The stable area must be kept clean at all times and aisles unobstructed.

HAUL-INS

The haul-in fee per horse is \$20 per day. Trailer and haul in parking in the parking lot across from the horse show office.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Entries must be received by **March 4/2018 or April 8/2018**. All cheques and money orders are to be made payable to Amberlea Meadows and must be mailed to:

- An entry is not considered valid until it has been paid in full. Absolutely no telephone entries. Entries may be faxed or emailed provided that these entries are paid by credit card and that a copy of the membership card is also attached. If mailing entry please ensure that entry is mailed in sufficient time to be received by closing date.
- Late entries, being those entries made before the show starts but after entries close, may be accepted with the approval of the Show Secretary. Late entries must be accompanied by a \$25 late entry fee. Any Competitors making any changes to the classes entered after the entry closing day will be subject to a \$15.00 penalty change.
- You must attach a copy of the current year competitors and owners membership card to your show entry form. Entries are not complete without the copy.
- A schedule of riding times will be available to all competitors on Tuesday, March 6 or April 10. For your scheduled times, ride times will be posted on our website at www.amberleameadows.com on Tuesday March 6 or April 10th. FINAL RIDE TIMES POSTED DAILY AT SHOW OFFICE. Ride times will be posted on Fox Village website, email will be sent to riders. (PLEASE BE SURE EMAIL ADDRESS ARE LEDGIBLE)
- Each NSF cheque will be charged \$40.00.
- Only one horse per entry form. The entry form may be photocopied.
- Please make sure when placing your entries that you are clear on which competition you are entering.
- The show organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- If time allows, horses may be entered Hors Concours (non-competitive). Such entries must pay the full entry fee and are subject to all Rules.
- HORSES MAY BE RIDDEN BY MORE THAN ONE RIDER AT A COMPETITION BUT NOT MORE THAN ONCE IN A DIVISION. Example: A Horse may enter Training Level with a Junior in the Junior and or Open Category. The same horse with a senior rider may enter First Level Adult Amateur and or Open Category. A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM MUST BE USED FOR EACH HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION.
- There will be no refund of entry fees after the official entry closing date except with a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate. 25% of the entry fees and the \$30.00 administration charge will be withheld. There will be no refund on stabling. No refund on entries will be granted after the first class starts on the first day of the show.
- Amberlea Meadows, Show Officials and Show volunteers shall not be responsible for any damages, losses, accidents, or any actions whatsoever that may occur to any entrant, owner, exhibitor, or spectator during the show. Parties execute a binding agreement upon signing of entry form.
